Council on Aging

- Work in collaboration to reach seniors in the community
 - Phone tree system where cast members each contact a few seniors by phone to communicate news/updates from senior center
 - Generating care packages and delivering to doorsteps in costume
 - Performing front yard skits- “singing telegram”
 - Buddy program- via zoom will share poetry, art, music, interests
 - Other acts of kindness for seniors

Vignette Development & Outdoor Performance

- Mrs. Fix will cast and write loosely connected vignettes that can be performed together or separately with group dances, singing potential, and puppetry
- Small group leadership and performance opportunity for interns
- All will be blocked and rehearsed with social distancing guidelines
- Performances will be outdoors

Costs: suggested donation of \$150

A serious commitment is required. There will be homework and projects to be done outside of rehearsal. The schedule will adjust as needed for performances and weather. Parents will need to provide transportation to rehearsals and performances once we are outside. Costumes will be taken home and cared for by cast with hair and makeup directives. Once we are rehearsing outside, a physician signed health form will need to be provided with the child's immunization record and stating they are fit for competitive sports and physical education unless otherwise noted.
