Theater Workshop Behavior Policy

Please read out loud with your student.

To ensure the quality and safety of the program, Theater Workshop has instituted policies that support the ideals of personal integrity and responsibility. In order to eliminate any confusion, the following are general rules concerning personal behavior:

- No gum chewing.
- Clean up after yourself.
- No wandering the halls. Students are not allowed to go to their classrooms for any reason.
- Be respectful of the rehearsal and performance space.
- No use of personal electronics (cell phones, etc.).
- No hitting, pushing, pulling or touching anyone in a way that is threatening or uninvited.
- No carrying other students. Do not ask anyone to lift you.
- No ridiculing or teasing anyone.
- No touching others costumes, props, or instruments.
- No one may leave rehearsal without permission.
- If traveling with A-OK!:
 - Students must stay with the adult they are driving with.
 - Students will be respectful, calm and follow directions. No running will be permitted.

A student that has inappropriate behavior will be given a warning. If the problem continues, the student will be given a time-out. Further problems will be handled by the Director in accordance with Theater Workshop's discipline policy. Repeated behavior problems or any assault will result in dismissal. There is zero tolerance for hateful or threatening language toward students, staff or volunteers.

Attendance Policy:
